- Members need to **wear appropriate closed-in footwear**. No bare feet.
- **No photography or video to be taken during class** except with permission from teachers.
- Keep personal property off the dance floor; under a chair is the best place.
- Please give the teachers your attention during teaching and refrain from talking.
- If you join a dance in progress where there is a line, try to join the end of the line rather than the front.
- Let people into the circle when they approach to join a dance.
- You are welcome to join the centre of the circle during general dancing, **providing you know the steps well and do not need to follow others**.
- Please remember to drink plenty of water, and wear cool light clothing and deodorant so that dancing is pleasant for everyone.
- We would appreciate the correct money when paying for classes.
- Any member wishing to make announcements or share advertising material should check with one of the teachers first.
